Around 80 mobile phones clapped in rhythm using new technology for motion on the web. During the presentation of Norinnova's innovation Prize at Næringslivsdagen (Business and Industry Day) 2013 in Tromsø, Research Scientist Njål T. Borch from Norut illustrated the new technology in practice.

The participants heard the sound of around 80 mobile phones clapping in rhythm.

“This may sound simple, but it is technically demanding. We demonstrated how we can get a quantity of different phones and tablets to be synchronized to fractions of a second, even though these were different brands, versions and connected to totally different networks,” says Borch.

MotionCorporation recently won Norinnova Technology Transfer's innovation prize for 2013, for developing of new technology for motion on the web.
